New Forest Basics Bank (NFBB) provides food and other essentials for people in need in New Forest District whom social work agencies refer to us.

Our work depends on a small team of volunteers to keep things going.

We operate from The Cabin behind the United Reformed Church on Lymington High Street (next to Elliott's and opposite Boots). We are open on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 10 am to 12 noon.

There are many ways in which volunteers can help us, for example

- sorting goods at the Cabin or at other local storage premises and checking dates
- making up parcels for people referred to us
- answering the telephone
- helping with deliveries of parcels perhaps twice a year or so
- contacting community groups who help people in need
- contacting schools or surgeries
- distributing our twice-yearly Newsletter
- fund raising, events such as trolley drops and
- generally keeping us running along including photos etc. for the website and publicity materials.

Confidentiality and team work are essential

Helping at The Cabin usually means two hours of fairly intensive activities; some of the parcels are quite heavy.

We ask for references for prospective volunteers as standard practice.

You might also like to join as a Member either as an individual or representing an organisation – the form is on our website. There is no charge for membership. Being a member gives you a voice and a vote at the Annual General Meeting.
